AGAINST PUBLIC EMPLOYEE BENEFITS

AGAINST RETIREMENT SECURITY

The "Freedom" Foundation joined a coalition in Oregon that worked to cut the "retirement, disability and health insurance fund" of public workers. They compared retirement security for working families to the Ponzi scheme orchestrated by Bernie Madoff.

AGAINST RAISING THE MINIMUM WAGE

The "Freedom" Foundation has repeatedly opposed increases in the minimum wage and has said that a \$15 minimum wage is "an idea so stupid only liberals can believe it."

AGAINST PUBLIC EDUCATION

The "Freedom" Foundation has fought for cuts to public schools and educator salaries. They have argued against increasing education funding, calling it unimportant and irrelevant to student outcomes.
